Cultural Awareness

The Spirit of Jiao Yülu

Jiao Yülu (1922-1964) was a model official of the CPC. He was assigned to work in Lankao, Henan Province, in 1962 as the county's Party secretary.

Over a period of two years, Jiao led the whole county in a campaign to combat sandstorms and water logging, thereby improving the unproductive salinealkaline soil. He died of cancer in May 1964. He is honored as a "model county Party secretary," a "good official of the Party", and a "good servant of the
