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前 言

职业教育是我国现代教育的重要组成部分,中等职业学校必须依据职业教育的要求与时俱进,不断进行教育教学改革。本书以最新版的中等职业学校公共基础课程的英语教材为编写依据,以培育学生的课程核心素养为着力点,以深化学校教育教学改革、提高课堂教学实效性为目标,以细化解读有关课程标准要求为基础,充分体现学生的主体地位,进而激发学生的学习自信,挖掘学生的英语学习潜力。本书题型与对口升学考试接轨,内容新颖,不仅可以科学地检测学生的学习效果,也可以有效地提高学生的解题能力。

本书共包括 20 套复习卷,每周 1 套。第 1 周复习第 1 单元,第 2 周复习第 2 单元,第 3 周综合复习第 1 单元和第 2 单元所学内容,第 4 周巩固练习第 1 单元和第 2 单元的内容,以此类推,循序渐进。学生通过反复滚动训练,可以巩固所学知识和提升解题能力。

本书每套试卷都包括单词拼写、单项选择、补全对话、完形填空、阅读理解、翻译和书面表达七种题型。其中,单词拼写主要考查《英语》(拓展模块)每个单元中的重要词汇;单项选择主要考查《英语》(拓展模块)每个单元中的重点词汇、语法和交际用语,旨在提升学生的语言基础应用能力;补全对话、完形填空、阅读理解、翻译和书面表达旨在提高学生的阅读和写作能力。

由于编者能力有限,书中难免存在不当之处,恳请广大师生在使用后提出宝贵的意见和建议,以便我们及时做出修正。

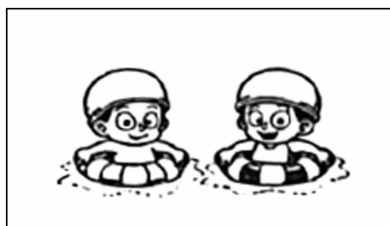

As the saying goes, "If at first you don't succeed, try, try again." This is never truer than when you are trying to master English. Lai Shixiong, a respected English master from China, has a story to share.

Like many non-native speakers, Lai failed when he first started learning English. When he was in high school, he once got an unbelievably low mark of 7 out of 100 on an English test. He almost gave up on English, but then he entered a military school, where he met a classmate who was good at English.
