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前 言

本书共包括 20 套复习卷,每周 1 套。第 1 周复习第 1 单元,第 2 周复习第 2 单元,第 3 周综合复习第 1 单元和第 2 单元所学内容,第 4 周巩固练习第 1 单元和第 2 单元的内容,以此类推,循序渐进。学生通过反复滚动训练,可以巩固所学知识和提升解题能力。

本书每套试卷都包括单词拼写、单项选择、补全对话、完形填空、阅读理解、翻译和书面表达 7 种题型。其中,单词拼写主要考查《英语》(基础模块 3)每个单元中的重要词汇;单项选择主要考查《英语》(基础模块 3)每个单元中的重点词汇、语法和交际用语;补全对话主要考查学生交际应用英语的能力;完形填空、翻译主要考查学生的语言知识综合运用能力;阅读理解和书面表达旨在提高学生的阅读和写作能力。
